

FUSED GLASS DICHROIC PENDANTS

\$35 class fee for AGS members, \$45 for non-members, plus \$15 materials fee: includes assorted glass, 4 glue on bails, firing. I will supply the tools needed for the class.

Minimum of 3 students, maximum of 6 students for social distancing



Due to requests, I am teaching this class again, in time to create a few unique gifts for the holiday season. We will create 4 pendants, learning different techniques and then students will have time to work on their own, designing their own glass. We will be making a variety of glass pendants approx. 1 x 1 ¼ inches and casting four pieces of glass in molds, that can be used as small pendants or buttons. You will learn about dichroic glass and its properties as it is the most popular glass used in

fused glass jewelry.

This class is for beginners and those who have some experience. It will give students an overview of the glass fusing process and an understanding of what is involved. Glass cutting will be taught, and students will have a chance to practice their skills. Participants will have the opportunity to work with different glass combinations on a small scale and gain experience in ways to combine glass.
